With certain exceptions, the Washington Wholesome Eggs and Egg Products Act, Chapter 69.25 RCW, requires that egg handler and egg dealer licensees provide proof that all eggs and egg products provided in intrastate commerce are produced by commercial egg layer operations whose existing facilities meet certain standards of the United Egg Producer's 2010 Animal Husbandry Guidelines (web address below), and whose new facilities (built after January 1, 2012) meet or are convertible to the 2011 version of the American Humane Association system plan for enriched colony housing (web address below). New facilities must also meet or be convertible to the standards identified in RCW 69.25.107.
